Carbery Enterprise Group ensures local businesses get "showcased"



Flying the flag for crafts and products made in West Cork is a new stand just set up in The Loop, Cork Airport - so keep a look out for the *madeinwestcork* stand when passing through. Business is booming!

This breakthrough came about through the perseverance of Carol Gilbert in persuading the Airport Authority to introduce a new stand for locally manufactured goods. The *madeinwestcork* logo is Carol's idea and it will give local entrepreneurs an opportunity to display their wares under its umbrella.

The stand currently stocks the Clonakilty-based Gosling Games' cup cake and car cookie puzzles and greeting cards with recipes. From Courtmacsherry, there are Abbey Crafts' unique handmade and hand painted porcelain figures produced by husband and wife team, Philippe Orsatti and Gillian Nunan. There's also a selection of Carol Gilbert's photographs, images of West Cork, in mounts, all ready to frame and easy to carry on board.

Due to its success plans are already proceeding to place stands in airports and other spaces (hotels, etc.) in Cork and further afield.

Carol Gilbert is a member of the Carbery Enterprise Group, a voluntary group whose mission is to create sustainable jobs in rural communities. She is also the main driver behind the 1 year, full-time, UCC MSc Organic Horticulture

Other projects currently being pursued by the Carbery Enterprise Group include the connection of all businesses in Skibbereen to a Fibre Optic Cable (part of the MAN system) with a pilot scheduled to be started in January 2013. This breakthrough will give world class communications to the town but will not increase the telecommunications bills.

Another Carbery Enterprise Group member and Chairman of CCJ, John Kearney has started production on a new fish processing venture where locally caught fish are given added value and sold through Irish multiples. This project supports sustainable jobs both in the area of raw material supply and the production of the finished product. We wish John well in his endeavours.

Tallow Enterprise Group, Co. Waterford

Located in West Waterford on the Cork border, Tallow Enterprise Group was established in 1986 by Tallow Credit Union as an independent enterprise group.

The Credit Union has in the past and continues to provide it with strong support in servicing a community of 1,000 people. It is currently managed by a voluntary board of seven people, five businessmen, a housewife and a farmer. It has just completed two modules of a Tallow Futures Project with the aid of a professional facilitator.

The aim is to imagine Tallow in 2030 and the integrative measures required from 27 local voluntary organisations in the community to build a new and exciting "Tallow of the Future". Tallow Enterprise has developed an enterprise centre – a conversion from an old garage, a training centre, crèche, information office, staff offices and meeting rooms. It is named the 'Nora Herlihy Centre' to commemorate a founding member of the Irish Credit Union Movement.

The Enterprise Group has supported a range of developments including maintaining the Andrew Carnegie Library which was due to close in late 2011, assisting in a range of projects, mentoring individual entrepreneurs, contributing finance to the community hall and children's playground. It sees its main work as providing business supports to individuals and groups involved in startup enterprises and those involved in the various social and recreation groups in the community.

Since its inception it has helped eighty people to start companies. It has currently thirty people employed in five enterprise and work-training programmes (TUS, FAS, CES and Pobal). It is an outstanding example of social enterprise in action in rural Ireland today.

Tallow Enterprise Group under Chairman Sean Tobin, a successful local businessman, is a member of CCJ.
